To accompany the petition of Leo J. Sullivan for an amendment of the laws relative to the retirement of certain veterans in the service of the Commonwealth or any political sub-division thereof. Pensions.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Three.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING LAWS RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF CERTAIN VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter thirty-two of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out section fifty-eight, as appear-
3 ing in the Tercentenary Edition, and inserting in
4 place thereof the following section: —

5 *Section 58.* A veteran who has been in the service
6 of the commonwealth, or of any county, city, town
7 or district, for a total period of twenty years, shall, at
8 his own request, with the approval of the retiring
9 authority, be retired from active service at one half
10 the regular rate of compensation paid to him at the
11 time of retirement, and payable from the same source.
