To accompany the petition of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, by Timothy F. Shea, for legislation to require uniform regulations as to maintenance for employees in all institutions of the Department of Correction. Public Service.

AN ACT REQUIRING UNIFORM REGULATIONS AS TO MAINTENANCE FOR EMPLOYEES IN ALL INSTITUTIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section twelve of chapter one hundred
2 and twenty-five of the General Laws, as appearing in
3 the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended as fol-
4 lows:— That a uniform set of rules and regulations
5 pertaining to maintenance of employees shall be
6 made optional with the individual employee upon
7 his acceptance of the position or some other provision be
8 made that after an appointment of a person is made
9 and said appointment does not require that person
10 to live in the institution, that at no time thereafter
11 can such person be required to do so unless under
12 emergency and then only providing he would be paid
13 the regular per annum salary for which his status calls.

1 SECTION 2. That a uniform "live-in system" be
2 installed in all penal institutions affecting only those
3 employees who would be required to live in.
