To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives:

I am returning to you herewith under Article LVI of the Amendments to the Constitution a RESOLVE REVIVING AND CONTINUING THE SPECIAL COMMISSION APPOINTED TO INVESTIGATE AND STUDY INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS, being Senate Bill No. 444, with the recommendation that the appropriation for said commission be \$2,500 instead of \$5,000.

I am informed that in addition to this amount which was allowed the commission last year, there is an unexpended balance of the previous appropriation still available.
