The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Three.

AN ACT TEMPORARILY INCREASING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN PERSONS HOLDING OFFICE BY APPOINTMENT BY THE GOVERNOR WHOSE SALARIES ARE PAID FROM THE TREASURY OF A COUNTY, CITY OR TOWN.

1 *Whereas*, Chapter one hundred and seventy of the
2 acts of the current year, relative to temporarily
3 increasing the salaries of officers and employees in the
4 service of the commonwealth, did not include within
5 its terms persons in the service of the commonwealth
6 whose salaries are not paid from the treasury thereof,
7 and the purpose of this act is in part to provide the
8 same increases in salary for the persons last referred
9 to, and for the same periods of time, as are provided
10 in said chapter one hundred and seventy, therefore
11 it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, neces-
12 sary for the immediate preservation of the public
13 convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter one hun-
2 dred and seventy of the acts of the current year shall
3 apply to the salaries of all persons holding office filled
4 by appointment by the governor who are paid from
5 the treasury of any county, city or town, to the same
6 extent as though the benefits provided by said provi-
7 sions had been expressly granted thereby to said
8 persons, except that said provisions as applied to
9 such salaries shall be administered by the appropriate
10 officers of such county, city or town instead of by
11 the division of personnel and standardization of the
12 commission on administration and finance and the
13 comptroller.

1 SECTION 2. Section six of said chapter one hun-
2 dred and seventy is hereby amended by inserting
3 at the end the following:— or of any person ap-
4 pointed by the governor, with or without the advice
5 and consent of the council, to a position, board or
6 commission and paid from the treasury of a county,
7 city or town.
