AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETIREMENT OR RESIGNATION OF JUDGES WHO HAVE SERVED IN THE APPELLATE DIVISION OF THE DISTRICT COURTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section sixty-five A of chapter thirty-two of the
2 General Laws, as amended by section five of chapter
3 four hundred and fifty-one of the acts of nineteen
4 hundred and thirty-nine, is hereby further amended
5 by adding at the end the following:— A justice of a
6 district court who retires or resigns in accordance
7 with the provisions of this section and who has served
8 continuously for ten years prior to such retirement or
9 resignation in the appellate division of the district
10 courts shall, in addition to all other amounts received
11 under the provisions of this section, be entitled to
12 receive a pension for life equal to three fourths of
13 the average annual compensation paid him for his
14 services on the appellate division of the district courts
15 during the ten years next preceding such retirement or
16 resignation.
