## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Six.

AN ACT REQUIRING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO PROVIDE AN UNDERGROUND GARAGE FOR THE PARKING OF AUTOMOBILES AND SO FORTH UNDER BOSTON COMMON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The city of Boston by its park commission shall
- 2 build an underground garage to provide parking
- 3 facilities for motor vehicles under Boston common.
- 4 There shall be a tunnel constructed through the garage
- 5 from Commonwealth avenue at Arlington street
- 6 through to Leverett street at Craigie bridge, the cost
- 7 of construction and maintenance to be paid for by the
- 8 city of Boston derived from rental revenues.
