### AN ACT FOR ADJUDICATION OF RESTORATION OF SOUNDNESS OF MIND.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Whenever any person who shall have been adjudged  
2 insane desires to be declared to be again of sound  
3 mind, a petition may be presented to the court making  
4 adjudication for a finding and order declaring that  
5 such person is at such time of sound mind. Such  
6 petition shall be made on forms to be provided by the  
7 court.
