AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MEDFORD TO COMPENSATE THE MEMBERS OF ITS BOARD OF ALDERMEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section eight of chapter three hundred
2 and forty-five of the acts of nineteen hundred and
3 three, as amended by section one of chapter sixty-one
4 of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-eight, is
5 hereby further amended by adding at the end the
6 following paragraph:—

7 The aldermen shall receive in full compensation for
8 their services as members of the board, or of any
9 committee thereof, such salary as may be established
10 by ordinance, but not exceeding seven hundred and
11 fifty dollars per annum for each member.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect January
2 first, nineteen hundred and forty-seven.
