AN ACT REPEALING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF LAW MAKING THE MEDICAL EXAMINATION OF CERTAIN WAR VETERANS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE A PREREQUISITE TO THEIR RETIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

4 hundred and forty-five, is hereby repealed.
