AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF NORTH ANDOVER TO RAISE, APPROPRIATE, AND ACCUMULATE FUNDS FOR A SCHOOL BUILDING PROGRAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of North Andover is hereby  
2 authorized to raise and appropriate annually to an  
3 accumulative school building fund an amount not  
4 exceeding fifteen dollars per pupil enrolled in the  
5 public schools of the town on the October first pre-  
6 ceding each such annual appropriation.

1 SECTION 2. The town treasurer shall be the custo-  
2 dian of said school building fund, and shall deposit  
3 it in one or more Massachusetts savings banks or  
4 invest it in bonds which are legal investments for the  
5 savings banks of this state.

1 SECTION 3. The town at a regular or special town  
2 meeting may vote to make expenditures from said

3 school building fund for the procuring and prepara-  
4 tion of sites for school buildings and for the erection,  
5 enlargement and equipping of school buildings, and  
6 for other purposes normally incident to the aforesaid  
7 activities.
