### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WOBURN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and seventy-two  
2 of the acts of eighteen hundred and ninety-seven is  
3 hereby amended by striking out section twenty-four  
4 and inserting in place thereof the following: —

5 *Section 24.* The salary of the mayor shall be three  
6 thousand dollars per annum.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for accept-  
2 ance to the registered voters of the city of Woburn  
3 at the biennial state election in the current year in  
4 the form of the following question which shall be  
5 placed upon the official ballot to be used in said city  
6 at said election: — “Shall an act passed by the gen-  
7 eral court in the year nineteen hundred and forty-  
8 six, entitled ‘An Act relative to the salary of the

9 mayor of the city of Woburn', be accepted?" If a  
10 majority of the votes cast on said question is in the  
11 affirmative, this act shall take full effect on January  
12 first in the year nineteen hundred and forty-eight,  
13 otherwise it shall have no effect.
