AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF PLYMOUTH TO PARTICIPATE IN CO-OPERATIVE SHORE PROTECTION AND REPAIR OF DAMAGE IN CERTAIN TOWNS IN SAID COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the  
2 county of Plymouth are hereby authorized to parti-  
3 cipate in the work of shore protection and repair of  
4 damage done by storms in certain towns in said  
5 county, and for such purpose may pay such sums  
6 as may be necessary, not to exceed per  
7 cent of the cost of such work, in co-operation with  
8 the commonwealth and with the towns in which such  
9 work is done, or in co-operation with the common-  
10 wealth and said towns and the federal government.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose aforesaid, the trea-  
2 surer of said county, with the approval of the county

3 commissioners, may borrow upon the credit of the  
4 county such sums as may be necessary, not exceed-  
5 ing, in the aggregate  
6 and may issue bonds or notes of the county therefor,  
7 which shall bear on the face the words Plymouth  
8 County Shore Protection Loan, Act of 1946. Each  
9 authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan  
10 and such loans shall be payable not more than  
11        years from their dates. The bonds or notes  
12 shall be signed by the county treasurer and counter-  
13 signed by a majority of the county commissioners.  
14 The county may sell the said securities at public  
15 or private sale, upon such terms and conditions as  
16 the county commissioners may deem proper, but not  
17 for less than their par value. Indebtedness incurred  
18 hereunder shall, except as herein provided, be sub-  
19 ject to chapter thirty-five of the General Laws.

1    SECTION 3. The county treasurer of said county,  
2 with the approval of the county commissioners, may  
3 issue temporary notes of the county, payable in not  
4 more than one year from their dates, in anticipation  
5 of the serial bonds or notes under this act, but the  
6 **time** within which such serial bonds or notes shall  
7 become due and payable shall not, by reason of such  
8 temporary notes, be extended beyond the time fixed  
9 by this act. Any notes issued in anticipation of  
10 the serial bonds or notes shall be paid from the  
11 proceeds thereof.

1    SECTION 4. This act shall take full effect upon  
2 its acceptance, during the current year, by the county  
3 commissioners of the county of Plymouth, but not  
4 otherwise.
