AN ACT REQUIRING THE PRESENCE OF AT LEAST THREE EXAMINERS FROM THE BOARD OF REVIEW IN THE DIVISION OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY AT HEARINGS BEFORE THE BOARD AND PROHIBITING PARTICIPATION IN THE DECISION BY A MEMBER ABSENT FROM THE HEARING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section forty-one of chapter one hundred and fifty-
2 one A of the General Laws, as appearing in section one
3 of chapter six hundred and eighty-five of the acts of
4 nineteen hundred and forty-one, is hereby amended
5 by adding at the end thereof the following para-
6 graph: —

7 At hearings before the board at least three examiners
8 shall be present, and no member shall take part in
9 the decision who was not present at the hearing.
