AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE STATUS OF CERTAIN PERSONS
EMPLOYED IN THE OPERATION OF THE DRAWS OF CER-
TAIN BRIDGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section one of chapter six hundred and ninety of
2 the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-five is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the word "fund" in the
4 twenty-first line the following sentence:— There-
5 after, all such employees employed as lock and draw
6 helpers, lock and draw operators, draw tenders or
7 assistant draw tenders shall be subject to the pro-
8 visions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws, and
9 all rules and regulations thereunder promulgated, and
10 shall be entitled to the benefit of all applicable pro-
11 visions of law relative to retirement and pensions,
12 and to all accrued vacation, sick leave and seniority
13 rights.
