AN ACT RELATIVE TO ABOLISHING AGE LIMITS IN THE EMPLOYMENT OF VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 No maximum age limit shall be established through
2 any rule or regulation affecting the entrance age in
3 any employment by the commonwealth of Massa-
4 chusetts, or any political subdivision thereof, which
5 may apply to veterans however described in the Gen-
6 eral Laws and including veterans of World War II,
7 and it is further provided that any rule or regulation
8 at present in effect relative to maximum entrance age
9 in said employment shall become inoperative as ap-
10 plicable to veterans upon passage of this act.
