The committee on Transportation, to whom were referred the special report of the Department of Public Works (under chapter 48 of the Resolves of 1945) relative to the abolition of certain railroad grade crossings in the city of Cambridge and the town of Framingham (House, No. 176) the petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 269) of Robert L. Lee that provision be made for the abolition of certain grade crossings in the city of Cambridge, the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 506) of Jeremiah J. Sullivan for legislation to provide for the abolition of certain grade crossings in the city of Cambridge, and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1433) of Joseph F. McEvoy, Jr., that the Department of Public Works be authorized to abolish certain grade crossings at Davis Square in the city of Somerville, report the accompanying resolve (House, No. 1503).

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION RELATIVE TO
THE ABOLITION OF CERTAIN RAILROAD GRADE CROSS-
INGS IN THE CITIES OF CAMBRIDGE AND SOMERVILLE
AND THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission es-
2 tablished by chapter forty-one of the resolves of nine-
3 teen hundred and forty-five shall, in the course of its
4 work, investigate the subject matter of current senate
5 document numbered two hundred and sixty-nine and
6 of current house document numbered five hundred
7 and six, relative to the abolition of certain railroad
8 grade crossings in the city of Cambridge, and the
9 subject matter of current house document numbered
10 fourteen hundred and thirty-three, relative to the
11 abolition of certain railroad grade crossings in the city
12 of Somerville, and shall also consider the subject
13 matter of current house document numbered one
14 hundred and seventy-six, being a special report of the
15 department of public works relative to the abolition
16 of certain grade crossings in the city of Cambridge
17 and the town of Framingham. Said commission shall
18 include in its final report to the general court the re-
19 sults of its investigation hereunder and its recom-
20 mendation in relation thereto.
