RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL RELATIVE TO TRIALS BEFORE THREE JUSTICES OF THE SUPERIOR COURT.

1 *Resolved*, That the judicial council be requested to
2 investigate the subject matter of current senate docu-
3 ment numbered two hundred and thirty-four, rela-
4 tive to trials before three justices of the superior
5 court, and to include its conclusions and its recom-
6 mendations, if any, in relation thereto, with drafts
7 of such legislation as may be necessary to give effect
8 to the same, in its annual report for the year nine-
9 teen hundred and forty-six.
