By Mr. Bowker of Brookline, petition of M. Evelyn MacDonald Nyhen that the town of Brookline be authorized to pay to her an annual pension. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF BROOKLINE TO PAY
A PENSION TO M. EVELYN MACDONALD NYHEN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Brookline is hereby au-
2 thorized to pay to M. Evelyn MacDonald Nyhen, of
3 said Brookline, a pension in the annual sum of one
4 thousand three hundred and fifteen dollars and
5 twenty cents, the first annual payment to be made
6 to her in the calendar year in which the town of
7 Brookline shall accept this act; said M. Evelyn
8 MacDonald Nyhen being the widow of J. Albert C.
9 Nyhen, who served as bacteriologist in the health de-
10 partment of the town of Brookline for thirty-nine
11 years and died in that office on March twenty-fourth,
12 nineteen hundred and forty-one, at the age of sixty
13 years, without having completed arrangements for his
14 retirement, and as a result said M. Evelyn MacDonald
15 Nyhen is not entitled to receive any benefits under

16 the Brookline retirement system; and said sum of
17 one thousand three hundred and fifteen dollars and
18 twenty cents, being the amount which said M. Evelyn
19 MacDonald Nyhen would have been entitled to re-
20 ceive annually had her husband, said J. Albert C.
21 Nyhen, completed his retirement and provided for
22 her under option two, so called, in the Brookline
23 retirement act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by vote of the selectmen of the town of
3 Brookline.
