AN ACT RELATIVE TO DEDUCTIONS FROM THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN SCHOOL TEACHERS OF THE TOWN OF EASTON UNDER THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Deductions from the salaries of school  
2 teachers of the town of Easton heretofore made under  
3 the teachers' retirement system shall have the same  
4 force and effect as if their salaries on which such de-  
5 ductions were based had been paid wholly by the  
6 treasurer of said town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
