AN ACT REQUIRING THAT CERTAIN OFFICIAL REPORTS OF
MEDICAL EXAMINERS BE OPEN TO THE INSPECTION OF
CERTAIN PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Chapter thirty-eight of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section seven the following
3 section: —

4 *Section 7A.* Any official report of a medical exam-
5 iner made and filed as required by law shall be open to
6 the inspection of the next of kin of the deceased, his
7 attorney or agent, and copies thereof may be made by
8 such person.
