## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Six.

AN ACT FURTHER PROVIDING FOR SEWAGE DISPOSAL NEEDS OF THE NORTH AND SOUTH METROPOLITAN SEWERAGE DISTRICTS AND COMMUNITIES WHICH NOW OR HEREAFTER MAY BE INCLUDED IN SAID DISTRICTS.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would,  
2 in part, defeat its purpose, which is to provide for  
3 sewage disposal needs in the north and south metro-  
4 politan sewerage districts with the utmost expedition,  
5 therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency  
6 law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the  
7 public health, safety and convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district water supply  
2 commission, as enlarged by chapter seven hundred  
3 and five of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-five,  
4 for the purpose of carrying out the construction of  
5 project three of said chapter, the completion of project  
6 one of said chapter, and the investigations, borings,  
7 designs, plans and specifications only of the sewage  
8 treatment plant and appurtenant works at Deer  
9 Island of the north metropolitan sewerage district, a  
10 part of project two of said chapter, may expend,  
11 from the aggregate of fifteen million dollars, provided  
12 for in section one of said chapter, the balance of the

13 four million four hundred and fifty thousand dollars  
14 appropriated in said section one remaining unexpended  
15 on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and forty-six,  
16 plus sums not exceeding one million five hundred  
17 thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. From said one million five hundred  
2 thousand dollars, the commission is hereby author-  
3 ized to expend not in excess of two hundred thousand  
4 dollars for the investigations, borings, designs, plans  
5 and specifications only of the proposed Deer Island  
6 sewage treatment plant, this amount being in addi-  
7 tion to the four per cent authorized for the making  
8 of borings and surveys and the preparing of plans  
9 and specifications for each of the projects as provided  
10 in section seven of said chapter seven hundred and  
11 five, inasmuch as the construction cost of the Deer  
12 Island plant was not included in the fifteen million  
13 dollar aggregate authorized in section one of said  
14 chapter.
