AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT BY THE CITY OF LAWRENCE OF CERTAIN BILLS FOR MEDICAL AND OTHER SERVICES RENDERED TO CERTAIN VETERANS AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The payment of any reasonable bill
2 for medical, dental, nursing or hospital services ren-
3 dered after authorization therefor by the Commissioner
4 of Veterans' Affairs of the city of Lawrence to a person
5 entitled to aid and soldiers' relief under the provisions
6 of section seventeen of chapter one hundred and fifteen
7 of the General Laws or chapter eleven of the acts
8 of nineteen hundred and forty-two, or any similar
9 provision of law shall not be barred by or deemed to
10 be within the provisions of section thirty-seven of
11 Part II of chapter six hundred and twenty-one of
12 the acts of nineteen hundred and eleven.

1 SECTION 2. The payment of any reasonable bill
2 for medical, dental, nursing or hospital services ren-
3 dered to any municipal employee sustaining personal
4 injury within the provisions of chapter one hundred
5 and fifty-two of the General Laws shall not be barred
6 by or deemed to be within the provisions of section
7 thirty-seven of Part II of said chapter six hundred
8 and twenty-one.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take full effect upon its
2 acceptance by a majority of the members of the city
3 council of the city of Lawrence.
