### AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF NORWOOD TO RETIRE WILLIAM H. SULLIVAN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the public  
2 good and in consideration of his long and meritorious  
3 service, the town of Norwood, acting by its board of  
4 selectmen, may retire William H. Sullivan, who has  
5 served the town faithfully for nineteen years as chief  
6 of police, on an annual pension, payable monthly,  
7 equal to one half the salary received by him at the  
8 time of his retirement.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its  
2 acceptance by a majority of the registered voters of  
3 said town present and voting thereon at a special  
4 town meeting called for the purpose and held during  
5 the current year, but not otherwise.
