AN ACT REVIVING J. E. NEWTON COMPANY FOR CERTAIN
PURPOSES.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would
2 delay the conveyance of certain property by the
3 corporation revived thereby and it is essential that
4 such conveyance be effected as soon as possible;
5 therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency
6 law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the
7 public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 J. E. Newton Company, a corporation dissolved by
2 section one of chapter two hundred and three of the
3 acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-three, is hereby
4 revived and continued for the sole purpose of selling
5 and conveying certain property situated in the county
6 of Bristol and of distributing the proceeds of said sale
7 among those entitled thereto.
