## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Six.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION OF A SHELTER ON THE CONCORD TURNPIKE NEAR LAKE STREET IN THE TOWN OF ARLINGTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission  
2 is hereby authorized and directed to erect, at a cost not  
3 exceeding twenty-five hundred dollars, on land owned  
4 by said commission on the Concord Turnpike about  
5 one hundred feet from its intersection with Lake  
6 street in the town of Arlington, a shelter for use by  
7 the public; provided, that no work shall be done  
8 hereunder unless and until said sum of twenty-five  
9 hundred dollars is paid into the state treasury by the  
10 town of Arlington, the Boston Elevated Railway  
11 Company or interested citizens.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
