RESOLVE FURTHER INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION TO BE MADE BY THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO INVESTIGATE CERTAIN MATTERS RELATING TO PUBLIC EDUCATION.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission
2 established by chapter eighty-eight of the resolves
3 of nineteen hundred and forty-five for the purpose
4 of making an investigation of certain matters relative
5 to public education shall, in the course of its work,
6 investigate the advisability of providing further facilities
7 within the commonwealth for the higher education
8 of the inhabitants thereof so that the commonwealth
9 which has been the leader in educational
10 development may take the necessary steps to remedy
11 the lack of provision for study beyond the so called
12 high school courses. Said commission shall confer
13 with officials of other states which may have provided
14 for higher educational facilities for the purpose of
15 obtaining such advice and information as may be
16 helpful in making its investigation hereunder.
