Ordered, That the special committee authorized, by an order adopted by the House on May 24, 1946 and by the Senate on May 27, 1946, to sit during the recess of the General Court for the purpose of making an investigation relative to the organization and administration of the department of conservation shall, in the course of its investigation, consider the subject matter of current house document numbered sixteen hundred and ninety-one, relative to establishing the powers and duties of the chief moth superintendent in the department of conservation.
