Petition of Patrick J. McDonough relative to the salaries of court officers in attendance upon the Supreme Judicial Court in Suffolk County. The Judiciary.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Six.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARIES OF COURT OFFICERS IN ATTENDANCE UPON THE SUPREME JUDICIAL COURT IN SUFFOLK COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section seventy-three of chapter two
2 hundred and twenty-one of the General Laws, as
3 most recently amended by section one of chapter
4 four hundred and twenty-seven of the acts of the
5 current year, is hereby further amended by striking
6 out, in the second sentence, the words "five hundred
7 and twenty-eight" and inserting in place thereof the
8 words:— seven hundred and fifty, — so as to read
9 as follows:— *Section 73.* Each officer in attendance
10 upon the superior court in Suffolk county who is
11 appointed under section seventy shall receive from
12 said county in full for all services performed by him
13 such salary as shall be fixed by the justices of said
14 court, with the approval of the justices of the supreme

15 judicial court. Each officer in attendance upon the
16 supreme judicial court in said county shall receive
17 in full for all services performed by him such salary
18 as shall be fixed by the justices of the supreme judicial
19 court, of which salary seven hundred and fifty dollars
20 shall be paid by the commonwealth and the remainder
21 by said county. The officer in attendance upon the
22 land court in said county shall receive in full for all
23 services performed by him such salary as shall be
24 fixed by the judges of said court, with the approval
25 of the justices of the supreme judicial court. Each
26 officer in attendance upon the probate court in said
27 county shall receive in full for all services performed
28 by him such salary as shall be fixed by the judges of
29 said court, with the approval of the justices of the
30 supreme judicial court.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
