AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF THE BOARD OF WATER COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF DARTMOUTH, AND AUTHORIZING SAID BOARD TO EXERCISE AND PERFORM THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF SEWER AND DRAIN COMMISSIONERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The board of water commissioners of
2 the town of Dartmouth shall, in addition to the powers
3 and duties heretofore vested by law in it, exercise and
4 perform in said town all the powers and duties now
5 vested by law in the board of sewer and drain commis-
6 sioners of said town; and said board of water commis-
7 sioners shall hereafter be known as the board of water,
8 sewer and drain commissioners.

1 SECTION 2. The board of sewer and drain commis-
2 sioners of said town is hereby abolished; but nothing
3 in this act shall be deemed to affect the rights, powers

4 and duties of any employee of said board in office
5 on the effective date of this act, and said persons shall
6 hereafter serve under the board of water, sewer and
7 drain commissioners hereby established.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
