

To accompany the petition of Robert L. Lee and David M. Cleary that provision be made for the placing of four bronze tablets on Bunker Hill Monument and for the restoration of the property adjacent thereto. Metropolitan Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Six.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT FOUR BRONZE TABLETS SHALL BE PLACED ON BUNKER HILL MONUMENT TO COMMEMORATE THE SERVICES AND SACRIFICES OF PERSONS LIVING IN CHARLESTOWN WHO SERVED IN THE MILITARY OR NAVAL FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES IN THE CIVIL WAR, THE SPANISH WAR, IN WORLD WAR I AND WORLD WAR II, AND FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE PROPERTY ADJACENT THERETO.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commis-
2 sion, hereafter called the commission, is hereby
3 authorized and directed to procure four bronze tablets
4 as herein described and place the same on Bunker
5 Hill monument. One tablet shall contain the names
6 of residents of Charlestown who served in the civil
7 war; the second tablet shall contain the names of
8 such residents who served in the Spanish war; the

9 third tablet shall contain the names of such residents
10 who served in World War I and the fourth tablet
11 the names of such residents who served in World
12 War II. Said commission is further authorized and
13 directed to repair the walks and regrade the grounds
14 adjacent to said monument, and for the above pur-
15 poses may expend such sum or sums not exceeding
16 in the aggregate one hundred thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
