AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL ACCOMMODATIONS
FOR THE REGISTRY OF DEEDS IN CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Middle-
2 sex county are hereby authorized to raise and expend
3 a sum not exceeding thirty-eight thousand dollars
4 for the purpose of providing adequate accommoda-
5 tions for the registry of deeds at the registry of deeds
6 and probate building at Cambridge in said county,
7 and for such purposes said county commissioners may
8 make additions to the registry of deeds wing of said
9 building and may alter or remodel said registry of
10 deeds wing and do all things incidental thereto.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon
2 its acceptance by the county commissioners of the
3 county of Middlesex; provided, that such acceptance
4 occurs during the current year.
