AN ACT PERMITTING CERTAIN VETERANS TO APPLY FOR
REGISTRATION AS LICENSED FUNERAL DIRECTORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Any person who served in the armed forces of the
2 United States during World War II who was eligible
3 to be examined for registration as a funeral director
4 at the time of his entrance into such service, shall
5 be entitled to apply for such registration and be
6 examined notwithstanding the fact that he has not
7 been graduated from an approved funeral directing
8 school which gives a course of instruction of not less
9 than nine months.
