## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Six.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY AN UNPAID SPECIAL COMMISSION OF THE ADVISABILITY OF INCREASING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENT BOARD.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to  
2 consist of one member of the senate to be designated  
3 by the president thereof, three members of the house of  
4 representatives to be designated by the speaker  
5 thereof and three persons to be appointed by the gov-  
6 ernor, is hereby established for the purpose of investi-  
7 gating the subject matter of current house document  
8 numbered seventeen hundred and ninety-two, relative  
9 to increasing the membership of the Industrial Acci-  
10 dent Board. Said commission shall be provided with  
11 quarters in the state house or elsewhere, may travel  
12 within or outside the commonwealth, may hold hear-  
13 ings, and may expend for clerical and other services  
14 and expenses such sums, not exceeding, in the aggre-  
15 gate, twenty-five hundred dollars, as may hereafter be  
16 appropriated therefor. Said commission shall report  
17 to the general court the results of its investigations,

18 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts  
19 of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations  
20 into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the  
21 senate on or before the first Wednesday of December  
22 in the current year.
