In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE COMPUTATION OF SENIORITY FOR CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES IN CERTAIN CASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 15D of chapter 31 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended in paragraph 2 by inserting before
3 the word "transfer" the first time it appears therein
4 the following:— change of service whether by ap-
5 pointment, promotion, or, — by striking out the word
6 "transfer" the second time it appears and inserting
7 in place thereof the word:— change, — by striking
8 out the word "transferred" at the end of the sixth
9 line and inserting in place thereof the word:—
10 changed, — and by striking out the word "transfer"
11 in the last line and inserting in place thereof the word:
12 — change, — so that paragraph 2 will read as fol-
13 lows:— 2. In the event of a change of service whether
14 by appointment, promotion, or transfer of such an
15 officer or employee from one department of the com-

16 monwealth to another department thereof, from one
17 department to another in the same or another mu-
18 nicipality or from a municipality to the common-
19 wealth, or from the commonwealth to a municipality,
20 the length of his service shall be computed from the
21 date of said change until the completion of one year's
22 service in the position to which he is changed, upon
23 the completion of which the length of his service shall
24 be again computed from the same date from which
25 computed immediately prior to such change.
