AN ACT RELATIVE TO CIVIL SERVICE RE-EMPLOYMENT LISTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 in section 46I by adding after the first sentence the
3 following new sentence: — In case of resignation on
4 account of illness names shall be placed by the director
5 on the re-employment list only on the request of the
6 person so resigning., — so that it will read as follows:
7 — *Section 46I.* Whenever a person is separated from
8 the official or labor service for any reason other than
9 resignation or discharge, except resignation on account
10 of illness, his name shall be placed by the director on
11 the re-employment list, and shall remain on such list
12 for a period of five years or until he is appointed to a
13 position after certification from such list or reinstated
14 to a civil service position, but the foregoing shall not
15 apply to persons originally employed on requisition
16 for temporary service or to provisional appointees.

17 In case of resignation on account of illness names shall
18 be placed by the director on the re-employment list
19 only on the request of the person so resigning. There-
20 after, on requisition to fill any position which, in the
21 judgment of the director, can be filled from such re-
22 employment list, the director, before certifying from
23 the regular list, shall certify from such re-employment
24 list, in accordance with the rules relative to certifica-
25 tion, the names of persons then standing thereon in
26 the order of the dates of their original appointment.
