AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DESIGNATION OF EXAMINERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 13 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 in section 6 by inserting after the word "may" in
3 the first line the following:— notwithstanding any
4 provision of chapter 32, — so that it will read as
5 follows:— *Section 6.* The director of civil service
6 may, notwithstanding any provision of chapter 32,
7 designate persons outside of or in the official service
8 of the commonwealth, or of any city or town where
9 chapter 31 is in force, who shall, with the consent of
10 the head of the department or office in which any such
11 person in such official service serves, act as examiners
12 of applicants for any public employment and perform
13 such other duties as may be required by said director,
14 but no person elected by popular vote to public office
15 shall serve as aforesaid, nor shall any person so serve
16 when any relative or connection by marriage, within
17 the degree of first cousin, is an applicant.
