AN ACT AUTHORIZING TRANSFERS BY THE TRUSTEES OF MASSACHUSETTS TRAINING SCHOOLS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter 120 of the General Laws is 2 hereby amended by inserting after section 16 as
- 3 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition the following
- 4 section:
- 5 Section 16A. The trustees may transfer any person
- 6 committed or transferred to the Industrial School for
- 7 Boys, the Lyman School for Boys, or to the Industrial
- 8 School for Girls, still in the custody of the said trustees,
- 9 who proves upon examination by a physician qualified
- 10 as provided in section 53 of chapter 123 to be feeble-
- 11 minded and an improper person to remain in any of
- 12 the foregoing institutions, to the custody of the
- 13 department of mental health. Said department shall
- 14 designate the institution under its control to which
- 15 the person so transferred shall be sent. Any person

- 16 transferred under this section shall be accompanied
- 17 by all mittimuses and processes, a copy of the medical
- 18 report and a written statement covering the history
- 19 and conduct of the person, and the circumstances of
- 20 the person's home, so far as they can be ascertained.

 - 2 hereby amended by inserting after section 17, as
 - 3 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, the following
 - 4 section: -
 - 5 Section 17A. The legal custody of the remainder
 - 6 of his or her minority of any boy or girl transferred
 - 7 to the department of mental health by the trustees
 - 8 is hereby surrendered by them and shall thereafter
- 9 be in the institution to which the transfer has been 10 made.
