AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE WRITTEN ACCEPTANCE OF CANDIDATES OR ATTORNEYS THEREFOR ON NOMINATION PAPERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 50 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 453 of the acts of 1943,
3 is hereby further amended by striking out the last para-
4 graph and inserting in place thereof the following: —
5 “Written acceptance” shall mean acceptance signed
6 personally or by attorney duly authorized in writing,
7 and need appear on only one paper of a group of nomi-
8 nation papers necessary to secure a nomination.
