AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING POLICING AT ALL HORSE AND DOG RACING MEETINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8 of chapter 128A of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in section 3 of chapter 374 of the acts of
3 1934, is hereby amended by adding at the end the
4 following paragraph: —

5 The commissioner of public safety shall, upon a re-
6 quest by the commission, assign such number of state
7 detectives as he may deem necessary to be in attend-
8 ance at all horse and dog racing meetings. Such offi-
9 cers so assigned shall enforce the provisions of this
10 chapter, the rules prescribed by the commission and
11 the laws of the commonwealth. The licensee shall
12 pay to the department of public safety a sum equal to
13 the salaries of the state detectives so assigned for the
14 period of such meeting.
