By Mr. Murphy of Malden, petition of Robert F. Murphy for legislation making veterans eligible under civil service laws for examination for and appointment to positions in police and fire departments notwithstanding minimum age requirements. Civil Service.

AN ACT MAKING VETERANS ELIGIBLE FOR EXAMINATION FOR AND APPOINTMENT TO POSITIONS IN POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS, NOTWITHSTANDING MINIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 22A, inserted by chapter 221
3 of the acts of 1946, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following: —

5 *Section 22A.* No veteran shall be deemed ineligible
6 for examination for or appointment to police or fire
7 service because of established minimum age require-
8 ments for such examination and appointment; pro-
9 vided, that he meets all other requirements of the civil
10 service laws and rules.
