AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS ADDITIONAL VETERANS' BONUS TO THE DEPENDENTS OF PERSONS WHO SERVED IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES IN ANY PLACE DURING WORLD WAR II AND DIED AS A RESULT OF SUCH SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 731 of the acts of 1945, as most
2 recently amended by section 1 of chapter 581 of the
3 acts of 1946, is hereby further amended by adding at
4 the end the following paragraph:—

5 (3) Two hundred dollars to the dependents, as
6 determined under section three, of each person who
7 performed active service in any place and died as a
8 result of such service.
