RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF WILLIAM REED OF BOSTON.

1 *Resolved*, For the purpose of discharging a moral
2 obligation, there shall be paid from the treasury of the
3 commonwealth, subject to appropriation, to William
4 Reed of Boston the sum of twenty-five thousand
5 dollars to compensate him for injuries received while
6 an inmate of a state institution and to reimburse him
7 for expenses of hospital and medical care incurred
8 by him on account of said injuries.
