## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Seven.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR DISSOLVING LIENS FOR BETTERMENT ASSESSMENTS WHEN SUCH ASSESSMENTS HAVE BEEN PAID OR ABATED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 12 of chapter 80 of the General Laws, as  
2 most recently amended by section 4 of chapter 478  
3 of the acts of 1943, is hereby further amended by  
4 adding at the end the following sentence:— A lien  
5 under this section may be dissolved by filing for  
6 record in the registry of deeds of the county or dis-  
7 trict where the land subject to the lien lies a certificate  
8 from the collector of taxes that the assessment, con-  
9 stituting the lien, together with any interest and  
10 costs thereon, has been paid or legally abated.
