AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF PARKING METERS IN CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any city or town may, for the purpose of enforcing
2 its ordinances, by-laws, orders, rules and regulations
3 relating to the parking of vehicles subject so far as
4 applicable to section two of chapter eighty-five of the
5 General Laws, install, operate and maintain mechan-
6 ical devices known as parking meters; may make
7 ordinances, by-laws, rules and orders respecting the
8 same and may establish and charge a fee by the de-
9 posit of coins in such meters for the privilege of
10 parking vehicles under such ordinances, by-laws,
11 orders and rules on ways subject to such rules and
12 regulations within its control.
