AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPROPRIATIONS BY THE TOWN OF  
NANTUCKET FOR MUNICIPAL ADVERTISING PURPOSES  
AND FOR PUBLIC AMUSEMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 139 of the acts  
2 of 1937 is hereby amended by striking out, in the  
3 second line, the word "three" and inserting in place  
4 thereof the word: — six, — so as to read as follows: —  
5 *Section 1.* The town of Nantucket may, by a major-  
6 ity vote, appropriate each year a sum not exceeding  
7 six thousand dollars for advertising the advantages  
8 of the town and for providing amusements or enter-  
9 tainments of a public character. The money so  
10 appropriated by the town shall be expended under  
11 the direction of the board of selectmen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
