AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE MEMBERS AND THE SECRETARY OF THE LICENSING BOARD FOR THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291 of the acts of 1906 is
2 hereby amended by striking out section 2, as amended
3 by section 1 of chapter 305 of the acts of 1945 and
4 inserting in place thereof the following section:—

5 *Section 2.* The annual salary of the chairman of
6 said board shall be seven thousand dollars, that of
7 each of the other two members six thousand five hun-
8 dred dollars and that of the secretary six thousand
9 five hundred dollars. Such salaries shall be paid in
10 monthly instalments by the city of Boston. Subject
11 to the approval of the governor and council, said board
12 may provide itself with rooms, convenient and suitable
13 for the performance of its duties, the rent of which

14 shall be paid by the city of Boston. Said rooms shall
15 be suitably furnished, and equipped, and the expense
16 thereof shall be paid by said city upon requisition by
17 said board.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
