## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Seven.

AN ACT DISQUALIFYING PUBLIC OFFICERS FROM HOLDING PUBLIC OFFICE AFTER BEING CONVICTED OF CERTAIN CRIMES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Any person who is hereafter finally convicted of  
2 committing a felony in connection with the perform-  
3 ance of the duties of any public office in the common-  
4 wealth, shall forfeit his office and be forever disqualified  
5 to hold any public office, trust or appointment under  
6 the constitution or laws of the commonwealth.
