## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE SALARY OF ENGINEERS, CHEMISTS AND OTHER TECHNICAL GROUPS OF EMPLOYEES AFTER A PERIOD OF YEARS IN GRADE IN THE SERVICE OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The salary of engineers (class 27), chemists (class  
2 34), supervisor of bridge maintenance and operation  
3 (class 1), and highway landscape supervisor (class 1),  
4 as classified under civil service rule four, in the official  
5 service of the commonwealth, after having been at  
6 the maximum step of their grade for a period of five  
7 years, and not having been promoted into the next  
8 higher grade, shall be increased by one salary step in  
9 said grade, with an additional salary step after each  
10 successive five-year period. Upon the promotion of  
11 said employee while receiving such additional salary  
12 step or steps, he will receive a salary in his new grade  
13 at a step-level next higher to his existing salary.
