AN ACT PERMITTING ANY TOWN TO RECONSIDER ITS ACCEPTANCE OF CERTAIN ACTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 39 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by inserting after section 10 the following new sec-  
3 tion:—

4 *Section 10A.* At its annual town meeting held  
5 next after a biennial state election at which it voted  
6 to accept the provisions of any act directly or in-  
7 directly affecting its finances, any town may vote to  
8 reconsider, and may thereupon nullify or approve,  
9 such acceptance.
