RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT FROM THE STATE TREASURY OF A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO HYMEN J. SCLAR.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of discharging a
2 moral obligation of the commonwealth, and after an
3 appropriation has been made therefore, there shall be
4 allowed and paid out of the treasury of the common-
5 wealth to Hymen J. Sclar the sum of
6 dollars in full settlement of his claim against the
7 commonwealth, for injuries sustained in the line of
8 duty while attending the Massachusetts state guard
9 encampment at Camp O'Connor, in Framingham,
10 Massachusetts, in the year nineteen hundred and
11 forty-five. No payment shall be made hereunder
12 until there has been filed with the comptroller an
13 agreement signed by said Hymen J. Sclar that the
14 amount, if any, paid or to be paid for legal services
15 rendered in connection with the passage of this
16 resolve shall not exceed ten per cent of the amount
17 paid hereunder.
